2024-2025 Tuition Schedule and Policies

Registration Fee: A non-refundable fee of \$200 made payable to Zion's Hill Preschool Program must accompany the signed confirmation of submission. The registration fee for each additional child is \$75.

Tuition Payments: Tuition is paid in four installments to Zion's Hill Preschool Program via check or through the Procare app. Families are responsible for timely payments on or before the following dates:

1st payment dueMay 15th2nd payment dueOctober 15th3rd payment dueJanuary 15th4th payment dueMarch 15th

Fees: Payments processed through Procare are subject to a \$1.00 fee for ACH transfers, and a 2.7% fee for credit card transactions. There is a \$25 fee for returned checks.

Late payments will be subject to a \$50 late fee for every seven days that tuition is past due. After thirty (30) days of non-payment, the classroom space will be forfeited for the remainder of the school year without a refund. Members whose accounts are not paid in full by April 15, 2025 will forfeit registration for the 2025-2026 school year. Please contact the Director in advance of tuition due dates to make arrangements and avoid late payment fees.

Financial Aid: Financial aid is available on a confidential basis to families experiencing financial difficulties. Also, families for whom the four installment payment structure presents a hardship may request alternate payment options. Financial aid applications are available from the Director. We strive to make financial aid available. However, due to budget limitations, Zion's Hill Preschool Program may not be able to provide financial aid to all applicants.

Rolling admission: New family applications will be accepted starting January 8, 2024, on a first come, first served basis. Families can complete the online registration and submit the applicable registration fees. All families will be notified of admission and program placement on January 31, 2024.

Tuition refund policy: If you withdraw your child from ZHPP prior to the first day of school, you may be entitled to a full refund of tuition paid, less a \$300 withdrawal fee, if the following conditions are met: 1) the Director receives thirty (30) days written notice; and 2) your child's program time is filled by a new member.

If you withdraw your child from ZHPP on or after the first day of school, you may be released from your remaining tuition obligation only if your child's program time is filled by a new member. No refunds will be given for tuition payments already made.

If you relocate outside of Fairfield County, you may be entitled to a prorated tuition refund, less a \$300 withdrawal fee, provided the following conditions are met: 1) your child is withdrawn prior to January 15, 2025; and 2) ZHPP receives sixty (60) days written notice.

If your child is accepted into a special education services program, you will be released from your contract, and your tuition will be refunded on a pro rata basis.

If the ZHPP Director determines that it is in the best interest for you to withdraw your child from ZHPP, or withdrawal of your child is necessary because the presence of the child is detrimental to the health, safety or progress of other children, your tuition will be refunded on a pro rata basis.
